

HOW TO TAKE TELEDENTAL PHOTOS

TAKING PICTURES OF TEETH CAN BE TRICKY.

So we have put together some information for you to help make it a little easier and to show you what type of photos we are looking for. Please don't stress if the pictures are not perfect.

How to position child for dental photos:

(See picture 1)

- Get your child to lie on the floor/carpet
- Place a pillow under your child's head
- You sit just above their head, bending your legs



Picture 1 - Ideal seating position

To take photo of the LOWER teeth

- Use fingers and thumb to pull away lower lip and the cheek - to see more teeth (See picture 2)
- Then take photo from directly above the mouth with flash on. Check the teeth are in focus.
- You can then crop the photo to just the mouth and teeth if possible. (See pictures 3 & 4 for examples)

HANDY HINT

As an alternative to using your fingers to keep your child's mouth open, you can use 2 spoons to gently move and hold the lips and cheeks back, to allow a clear view of their teeth. This can also be fun for older children to help you with taking the photos.



Picture 2 - Finger & thumb position

Repeat this for the other side
UPLOAD the cropped photos

- Lower LEFT back teeth
- Lower RIGHT back teeth

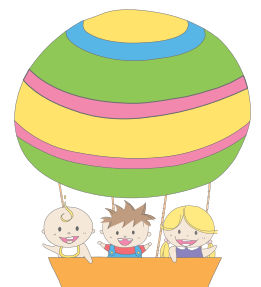

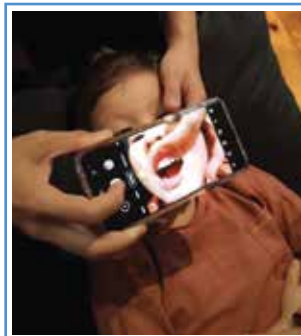
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To take photo of the upper front teeth

(See pictures 6, 7 & 8)

- Use fingers / thumb to pull away upper lip - to see upper front teeth (See pictures 6 & 7)
- Put the camera (phone) directly from the front of the mouth with flash on to take the photo. Check the teeth are in focus.
- You can then crop the photo to just the mouth and teeth if possible. (see picture 8 for example)

UPLOAD the cropped photo

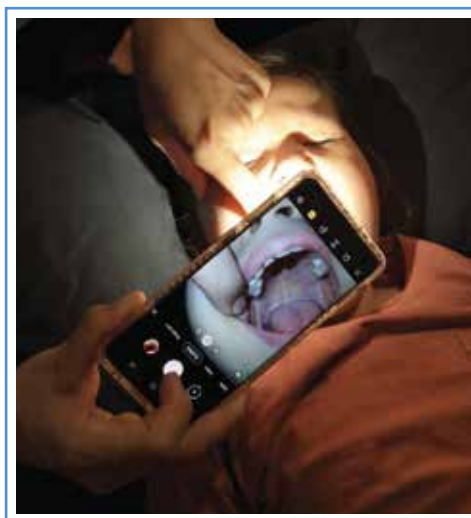
- **Front teeth with lip lifted**

To take photo of the UPPER teeth

- Use fingers and thumb to pull away lower lip and the cheek - to see upper teeth (See picture 9)
- Then take photo from directly above the mouth aiming towards the upper teeth, with flash on. Check the teeth are in focus.
- You can then crop the photo to just the mouth and teeth if possible. (See pictures 10 & 11 for examples)

Repeat this for the other side UPLOAD the cropped photos

- **Upper LEFT back teeth**
- **Upper RIGHT back teeth**
